Movie Night: *Bonhoeffer* Saturday, September 16 at 7:30pm: This dramatic documentary is about the young German pacifist and young Lutheran theologian Dietrich Bonhoeffer who resisted the Nazi regime and was hanged two weeks before World War II was over. The film conveys the essence of a man and his world, with his friends and family shedding light on his breakaway seminary, his travels to America and Harlem, his calls to change the world for better, and his noble attempts to respond to Nazi Germany as a Christian. Discussion afterwards will also focus on the insights and challenges Bonhoeffer still offers to contemporary America and current trends of neo-fascist and neo-Nazi racism.
