



Holy Communion Worship Services

Self-Assessment & Worship Precautions

Resurrection is pleased to offer limited-attendance Holy Communion worship services. For the safety of all, we expect worshippers to follow the self-assessment and worship precautions.

Participant self-assessment: We are trusting you to personally assess if it is safe for you to be in a public gathering – whether for your own risk or the risk you pose to others who will be in attendance or who you live with. We expect that anyone answering “Yes” to ANY of these questions will not participate in worship.

- Have you been experiencing any of the symptoms associated with COVID-19, including the following: coughing, fever, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, or early symptoms such as chills, repeated shaking with chills, body aches or muscle pain, sore throat, headache, diarrhea, nausea/vomiting, runny nose, and new loss of taste or smell?
- Have you tested positive for COVID-19?
- Have you had contact in the last 14 days with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or who has displayed the symptoms listed above?
- Have you traveled by airplane in the last 14 days?

Worship precautions:

- All worship participants **MUST** wear a mask and use hand sanitizer before entering the sanctuary.
- Attendance is limited to 15 households or groups who choose to worship together.
- Seating is marked to ensure appropriate distancing between households/groups.
- Doors to the building and sanctuary will be propped open.
- There is no congregational singing at this time.
- Those preparing and serving Holy Communion wear masks and gloves.
- At the conclusion of worship, everyone must directly depart the building and not gather in groups in the sanctuary or narthex. You may chat with other participants outdoors if you choose to do so.
- If you wish to bring an offering, there will be an offering plate near the sanctuary door
- Pews and other touched surfaces are wiped down or washed after each worship service. Worship materials are not re-used.
- Worship services are scheduled at least 60 hours apart to ensure droplets in the air have time to settle to the ground.
